

“Cast your bread upon the waters, for you will find it after many days”

These words come from Ecclesiastes 11:1. The language is unequivocal, and the fulfilment of this divine promise has been evident along the ages. In contrast to the ‘vanity’ that there is ‘under the sun’, the words God pronounces become fulfilled.

Bread is our basic food. It doesn’t grow as such from the ground, but it is a product which has been made by human hands. There has been much work between the wheat growing on the field and the finished bread, there has been much work in between. The farmer harvests the wheat, the miller turns it into flour, the baker kneads the flour and the other ingredients together and bakes the breads. When seeing the final product we can say to each one who participated, just like to the baker: this is ‘your’ bread.

It happens the same way with a recording, evangelical or containing Biblical teachings. There is much work between the written message and the recording itself. Someone planned it aiming to be scriptural (the Bible is the true wheat), went recording it, edited it and finally set it available for others. When you listen to it, you make it yours, and when you give it to somebody in prayer, you are casting ‘your’ bread. The same happens when you give away a tract or a book which has been very significant to you.

Once you have cast ‘your’ bread onto the waters, God works even where there is apparently no fruit. Verse 5 from Ecclesiastes 11 says that. You can then pray and trust. Many days can pass, you may forget what you have cast onto the waters, but God’s work continues. This way we can explain the promise that “you will find it after many days”. So then, as the verse 6 from the chapter we are in says,

“In the morning sow your seed, and at evening withhold not your hand, for you do not know which will prosper, this or that, or whether both alike will be good.”

DO YOU HAVE A CHINESE NEIGHBOR?

Some years ago, in Central Germany, a group of believers prepared 12.000 small packs with Christian literature in Chinese in order to give out to Chinese residents in the place. Many of them belonged to important Chinese families. It was an interesting project in which many young people from several local churches in the area participated. Maybe one of our readers feels a burden in his heart to the Chinese people living in his neighborhood, but doesn’t speak any word in their language. Why not use the CD **“Words of Life”** in Chinese?



This recording contains short stories, messages and evangelistic songs. It explains the way to salvation and gives basic Christian teaching.

If the person is interested in listening more about the message of the Bible, you can give him a second CD in Chinese, called **“Good News”**. It presents a general view of the Bible, from creation until Christ. It includes the salvation message and basic teaching about Christian life.

If the person shows even more interest, there are additional recordings in Chinese, which can let him grow in his knowledge about the Holy Scriptures. Some of them are:

- **“Portrait of Jesus”** – All scriptures about Jesus’ life, with music in between.
- **“Look, Listen and Live”** (8 CD series): Excellent for systematic evangelism and Christian teaching. It includes studies on the Old Testament, Jesus’ life and the first church.
- **“The living Christ”** (2 CD series). It illustrates the life of Christ, from creation until His second coming.
